If I weren't a skater, I would have been





Leon Qiao Our Literal Mover and Club Ice Shaker

When did you join the Atlanta FSC, and how did you first become involved as a volunteer?

I may want to take ice skating lessons in the future, but definitely limit it to learning how to skate fast and smooth, not how to spin or jump – and I know no matter how many skating lessons I will take, I will never be able to catch up to my kids on ice anymore.

Why do you stay involved as a volunteer with the Atlanta FSC?

When I first started, it was absolutely for Alice. I want her to skate in a great skating club, where younger skaters can make friends, have fun, help each other, and have great memories as part of their life. After joining the club and working in different areas as a volunteer, I learned that it does require huge amounts of volunteers' time and effort to keep our club running and growing in a health way, so my continuous contribution is definitely needed. Last and also the most important, our family has made many Atlanta FSC friends – their kindness, humor, enthusiasm, and support have been keeping us here!


Tell us a little about your background, profession, hobbies, and family.
