The 2021 MAGNOLIA OPEN and COMPETE USA as EXCEL Series participant competition will be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations of U.S. Figure Skating, as set forth in the current rulebook, as well as any pertinent updates which have been posted on the U.S. Figure Skating website.

SERIES INFORMATION:

The 2021 Magnolia Open competition is a designated Excel Series competition for the modified 2021 Excel Series. As an Excel Series event, skaters entered in the Series at eligible levels will earn points for their placement. Skaters who skate in a live competition will submit their protocol or final result sheet and submission form to the USFS Excel Committee for inclusion in the standings. Skaters participating in the Excel Series must compete at 1 live event. If conditions allow, an in-person Excel Final will be held in Strongsville, Ohio, during August. Details will be announced no later than June 15th, 2021.

Skaters must be registered for the Excel Series prior to competing at designated live competition; The deadline to register is May 2nd, 2021, or prior to your first competition, whichever is earlier. Registration for Excel Series [is available here](#). As 2021 Magnolia Open will be hosted prior to May 2nd, please submit your separate registration for the Series prior March 12th, 2021. There will be a separate registration fee.

Additional details and frequently asked questions can be found in the **modified handbook for the 2021 Excel Series**. For any questions related to the Excel Series, please contact ExcelSeries@usfigureskating.org. If you do not wish to compete in the Series, you may still compete in any Excel event without registration. Handbook can be found from [website here](#).

OPEN ELIGIBILITY/TEST LEVEL:

Eligibility: This competition is open to all eligible, restricted, reinstated or readmitted persons as defined by the Eligibility Rules and is a currently registered member of a U.S. Figure Skating member club in accordance with the current rulebook.

Test level: Competition level is the highest test passed as of the entry deadline, February 14th, 2021, in the discipline the skater is entering. Entrants may skate two levels above that for which they qualify (as stated in Technical Notification #250, exception due to testing difficulty during pandemic), but they may not skate down in any event. A skater may not compete in same Excel and Well-Balanced events. In case skater is interested in registering two levels higher than test level, please contact Competition Chair before signing up through Entry Eeze.

Age restrictions/requirements: Singles free skate events (Well Balanced Program) have the following requirements:

Juvenile: Girls – 12 years of age or younger; Boys – 13 years of age or younger;

Open Juvenile: Girls – 13 years of age or older; Boys – 14 years of age or older;

Intermediate: must be under the age of 18;

Adults: must be 21 years of age or older.

Skaters entering Pre-Juvenile and lower events will be divided as closely as possible by age, if the number of entries warrants more than one group.

COMPETE USA ELIGIBILITY/TEST LEVEL:

The competition is open to all skaters who are members of either the Learn to Skate USA Program and/or are full members of U.S. Figure Skating. To be eligible, skaters must be a member in good standing. If you are not a registered member through your rink, you must join a USFS member club every year by renewing membership.

ADULT LEVELS:

Eligibility will be based only upon highest free skate test level passed. Moves in the Field test level will not determine skater's competitive level. Skaters may skate at highest level passed or two levels higher (Technical Notification #250), but not different levels in the same event during the same competition. Skaters may not compete at more than one level in the same type event at the same competition. Skaters can be divided by age in all divisions. All events are separate, and there will be no final rounds.

Age classes for all free skate, dramatic entertainment, and light entertainment events in case dividing is required:

- Young Adult: 18 years through 20 years
- Class I: 21 years through 35 years
- Class II: 36 years through 45 years
- Class III: 46 years through 55 years
- Class IV: 56 years through 65 years
- Class V: 66 years and older

Age classes for all solo free dance and solo pattern dance events in case dividing is required:

- Young Adult/Class I/II: 18 years through 45 years
- Class III/IV/V: 46 years and older

All age classes may be divided or combined depending on the number of entries and at the discretion of the Chief Referee and/or the competition committee. Men and ladies can be combined in Adult 1 through adult bronze free skate events (based on the [Adult Competition Series rules](#)), and all levels of compulsory moves, solo dance, solo free dance, jumps, spins and dramatic/light entertainment events.

Men and ladies will not be combined in adult silver and higher free skate events. Athletes in adult silver and higher free skate events with no competitor of the same gender in another age class will be offered the opportunity to skate an exhibition for first place, skate up to the next higher level (if this provides a competitor) or be issued a refund. The Chief Referee reserves the right to request proof of age.

GROUP SPLITTING:

If there are more than 24 entries per event, rounds will be held in accordance with Rule 2460.

GOVERNING COUNCIL:

We will implement requirement changes approved at the May, 2020 [U.S. Figure Skating Governing Council](#). Please check our website and the U.S. Figure Skating website and [Technical Notifications](#) page for updates.

COMPETITION REGISTRATION

REGISTRATION (EntryEeze):

Entries will be accepted via EntryEeze at entryeeze.com with credit card only. Each transaction will include credit card fee. You can also access the registrations through Atlanta Figure Skating Club website atlantafsc.com by clicking a link under 2021 Magnolia Open or by choosing the logo of 2021 Magnolia Open from offered EntryEeze competitions.

DEADLINE:

Online registration opens on January 15th, 2021 at 8:00 am ET and closes on February 14th, 2021 at 11:59 pm ET.

Late entries will be subject to the approval of the Registrar and Chief Referee and will be assessed a late entry fee of \$30.00.

Skaters wishing to register for the competition will need their U.S. Figure Skating or LTS member number, be current

members in good standing.

Registration Deadline: February 14th, 2021 at 11:59 PM ET

FOREIGN SKATERS:

Non-U.S. skaters intending to register for this competition must set up a non-member account prior to registering for the competition and provide certificate of good standing from their national federation.

DANCE/DUET EVENTS:

Partnered Events: Only one partner will complete registration for the team. During the registration process, you will be asked to identify your partner and verify their test information. The registered partner will be responsible for managing all aspects of the competition for the team including music/PPC upload, practice ice sales, etc.

Athletes age 18+ as of the competition start date, who will be competing on a team (i.e. dance, duets) with at least one minor athlete, must complete SafeSport training. Minor Athletes who turn 18 mid-season are encouraged to seek parental consent to take the online SafeSport training early to avoid any disruptions in their ability to participate as the training is required upon turning 18. The athlete will not be SafeSport compliant until they have completed the training and their Members Only portal reflects completion. Please email safesport@usfigureskating.org for instructions or questions regarding parental consent.

IJS event as First Event * \$ 150

6.0 event as First Event \$ 130

* IJS event is always ranked as first event.

APPROVALS:

Club permissions and coach approval will be processed through Entry Eeze. After the completion of the skater's registration, e-mails will automatically be sent to the skater's club or LTS program, and coach for their approvals. Approvals consist of current membership, good standing, current skating level.

PLEASE NOTE:

Once a skater's event(s) have been coach approved, any entry change (event, level) after the close of entries is subject to referee approval and a \$25.00 change fee. No change will be processed until the fee is paid.

REFUND POLICY:

No refunds will be granted under ANY circumstances after entry deadline unless the event is cancelled. The Atlanta FSC reserves the right to divide an event, limit the number of entries, hold an event with only one entry and cancel an event (with refund) with only one entry. There will be no refunds for medical withdrawals. The online processing fees are non-refundable.

FACILITIES:

The competition will be held at The Cooler, which is located at 10800 Davis Drive, Alpharetta, GA 30004. The two ice

surfaces measure 200' x 85' with rounded corners and hockey barriers. The Cooler offers locker rooms and a bar/restaurant. Unfortunately, due to the pandemic possibility of offering locker rooms and availability to use restaurant services depends on the current national and local restrictions during the event. Participants will be notified about pandemic restrictions prior the event.

SCHEDULE:

Competitors may be scheduled on any day or time for the announced dates of the competition. Notification of competition and practice ice times will be available via Entry Eeze as soon as the schedule is finalized by the Chief Referee. The competition and practice ice schedule will not be available until the close of entries. Prior the closing of entries there will be no information about the possible pre-scheduling. All participants will be notified via email once schedule is available.

LIABILITY:

U.S. Figure Skating, the Atlanta Figure Skating Club, and The Cooler accept no responsibility for injury or damage sustained by any participant in this competition. This is in accordance with Rule 1600 of the official U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook.

JUDGING SYSTEMS:

IJS: The International Judging System (IJS) will be used for the following events: No Test – Senior Free Skate, Juvenile/Open Juvenile - Senior Short Program, Excel Free Skates, Pre Preliminary - Senior, and Adult Pre-Bronze – Masters, Free Skates.

6.0: The 6.0 Majority Judging System will be used for: Compete USA events, Excel Free Skate Beginner – High Beginner, Compulsory Moves , Jumps Challenge, Spins Challenge, Moves in the Field, Step Sequences, other Specialty events, and Showcase events and Solo/Partnered Dance Events.

Judging systems have been specified in the chart of offered events later in the announcement.

ENTRY EEZE MUSIC UPLOAD:

DEADLINE: SUNDAY FEBRUARY 28TH, 2021 at 11:59 PM ET

Competitors participating in events with music are required to upload their music to Entry Eeze registration system no later than **SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 28TH, 2021 at 11:59 PM ET**. After this date, skaters will be locked out of this feature and subject to a **\$25 late fee**. The late fee will be added to each skater's account who does not meet this requirement by the deadline. Late fees will not be removed under any circumstances and must be paid prior to registration onsite. Paid late fee is required in order to participate in the event.

Music can be uploaded in mp3 format as soon as registration has been finalized and events are paid for. In questions about uploading music, please contact Music Chairperson Todd Pettigrew tpettigrew0@att.net. Due to pandemic regulations uploading the music electronically is the only accepted method of providing program music.

A duplicate CD disc should be available in case of audio problems. Due to pandemic, CD copies will be accepted rink side only in a case of emergency, without covers and with the knowledge, that the disc will be sanitized with a disinfectant prior and post use. Back up music must be available rink side during the competition. Only CDs (standard CD-R format only) will be accepted for backups and must be clearly marked with the competitor's name, event, and running time. There can only be one track per disc.

Personal devices and memory cards such as cellphones will not be accepted due to sanitizing difficulties.

ENTRY EEZE PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT (PPC) – IF IJS:

DEADLINE: FRIDAY, MARCH 5TH, 2021 at 11:59 PM ET

Competitors participating in IJS events are required to submit PPC in Entry Eeze registration system no later than **FRIDAY, MARCH 5TH, 2021 at 11:59 PM ET**. After this date, skaters will be locked out of this feature in Entry Eeze registration and subject to a **\$25 late fee**. The late fee will be added to each skater's account who does not meet this requirement by the deadline. Late fees will not be removed under any circumstances and must be paid prior to registration onsite. Paid late fee is required in order to participate in the event.

PPC can be uploaded into Entry Eeze registration under the tab Planned Program Content. Short Program and Free Skate have separate entries and elements can be searched from a drop box in the order they appear in the program. Once saved PPC can be modified under skaters account until the deadline.

It is strongly recommended to utilize an online upload for PPC submission and not accept manual copies to avoid contamination and follow strictly pandemic mitigation rules. Any paper copies will not be accepted at the registration. In case deadline has passed, please contact Competition Chair tea.junnila@hotmail.com in order to deliver the required information for PPC.

ONSITE REGISTRATION/HEALTH CHECK-IN, MITIGATION RULES:

Registration will open one (1) hour prior the scheduled first event and run through the last event of the day. The registration table will be located adjacent to the entrance of the rink. Please register/check in promptly upon arrival. Allowed arrival times will be included into the event schedule. Entry into the facility will be limited to be able to follow maximum gathering limitations set by USFS, local and national authorities.

Please be prepared to a health check outside the arena prior entering the facility and note that event requires strict mask wearing policy and social distancing from all attendees including athletes, chaperones, officials and coaches. By registering into this event attendees acknowledge the policies and agree following them. All skaters are also required to sign required waivers by U.S. Figure Skating.

Due to pandemic the entry into the building will be limited and depends on the current national and local mitigation rules during the event. Attendees will be notified of the rules prior the event.

GENERAL

LOCKER ROOMS AND CHANGING AREAS:

Locker room availability is pending due to regulations during the event. Participants will be notified about current situation prior the event.

In case locker room use is possible, the rooms and changing areas at U.S. Figure Skating competitive events are for athletes only, will be labeled with regard to specific use and where identified will be gender specific. An exception can be made for athletes 11 years old and younger that will allow for one parent of the same sex to assist their child immediately prior to and after their skating event(s).

The use of any recording and photographic devices inside a locker room or changing area is strictly prohibited. Please review the Locker Room and Changing Area Policy and the SafeSport Handbook (both found on the [U.S. Figure Skating SafeSport](#) page, also, [locker room policy](#)). Any violation of this policy is punishable under the U.S. Figure Skating SafeSport policy and U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook.

All locker rooms will be monitored. If any concerns arise, immediately contact the monitor on duty. If there are any concerns regarding this policy, an athlete should change prior arriving at the competition.

PRACTICE ICE:

Practice ice will be available during the designated times throughout the competition. The cost of reserved practice ice (available for pre purchase at the time of registration through Entry Eeze is \$20.00 per 20-minute session. Skaters who reserve practice ice will have a selection period of one week in which to choose their sessions (maximum 2). This will be followed by open sales for any remaining practices at cost of \$25.00 for walk up sessions. No refunds will be granted for unused practice ice. Skaters who are more than five (5) minutes late to the session may forfeit their slot. No music may be played on practice sessions. Use of personal devices and ear plugs is strictly forbidden.

For additional information regarding practice ice offerings, visit Atlanta Figure Skating Club's competition website.

Zero tolerance in mask wearing includes every other time except after stepping on the ice. Masks should be placed in clean bags during practice ice and replaced to cover skaters' mouth and nose immediately as athlete steps outside the ice surface.

Inability to follow the mask wearing rule will have consequences and participant will be escorted outside from the venue.

PHOTO/VIDEO:

Professional video and photography services will be provided during the competition. Due to pandemic mitigation, online sales will be the only offered method. Events will be streamed on YouTube and viewable live free of charge. Each competitor will receive event videos that are included in the registration fee via emailed link.

For the safety and welfare of the skater, photography and videography will be permitted in the stands only and is restricted to hand-held battery operated equipment (no tripods). Flash photography is strictly prohibited while the competitors are performing. No one will be permitted to obstruct the view of other seated spectators by standing in front of or hanging over the plexiglass barriers or to film at alternative ice entrances. In order to comply with local fire safety codes, all isles within the stands must also remain clear. Non-compliance with this policy or refusal to comply immediately with requests from event officials will result in the violator being escorted out of the rink.

Note, [per U.S. Figure Skating policy](#), photographing and/or recording of any one other than your own skater is strictly prohibited. More information can be found from Basic Ice Usage and Skater Etiquette Information document; Club Resource section of Member's Only/USFS website.

AWARDS:

Results will be posted online only. Link for results will be added to the Atlanta FSC website under 2021 Magnolia Open Competition tab.

Open and Compete USA events: Medals will be presented to 1st through 4th place winners in each competition event. Duets and partnered events will receive a medal for each participant.

Ceremonies: Due to pandemic mitigation practices, awards ceremonies will be avoided and awards can be picked up from registration desk after results have been posted. The event will offer decorated podium for photo opportunity purposes. Social distancing is required during personal photography.

OFFICIAL NOTICES:

An official bulletin board will be maintained at the registration desk and also online under Atlanta FSC website under 2021 Magnolia Open tab. It is the responsibility of each competitor, parent and coach to check the online bulletin board frequently for any schedule changes and/or additional information. Skaters are requested to arrive at the entry door of the rink 45 minutes prior to the scheduled time of their arrival; individual arrival times will be added to the schedule. Arrival time will be approximately 30 minutes prior to the event starting time. A tentative schedule of events and arrival times will be posted prior to the competition after the entries have closed.

TEST CREDIT:

Skaters, that meet the requirements for test credit, may request their test credit forms at registration or pre-order them online (via Entry Eeze). Forms will be delivered to registration desk/greeting table in envelopes to avoid physical contact. No cash payments will be accepted, payments through Entry Eeze only to avoid contamination.

To receive credit, request a test credit package at registration by paying the fee of \$20.00 via Entry Eeze account beforehand or requesting prior your event onsite. The event level and the name of the skater must be mentioned in the request. The request must be done before the final IJS event of the competition has concluded.

IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR ALL COACHES:

To be a credentialed coach at a sanctioned nonqualifying competition, coaches must meet the compliance requirements listed below and verified by the U.S. Figure Skating.

Coach/Choreographer (domestic/non-foreign):

- ✓ Must be a current full member of U.S. Figure Skating either through a member club or as an individual member.
- ✓ If 18 years or older, must submit information for, proper payment of \$30 and successfully pass a background check. *
 - The background check will be valid for two seasons, the one in which it was completed plus one additional.
- ✓ If 18 years or older, must complete annual SafeSport Training. *
 - The training will be valid for 365 days from date of completion and there is no cost for the training/certification.
- ✓ Must complete the Professional Coach/Choreographer Coaching Education Requirement (CER) through the [Professional Skaters Association \(PSA\)](#).
- ✓ Must submit proof of general liability insurance with limits of \$1 million per occurrence/ \$5 million aggregate.
- ✓ Must agree to the U.S. Figure Skating Code of Ethics. *
- ✓ Must complete three waivers: 1) Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Release and Indemnification Agreement, 2) Medical Consent and 3) Name and Likeness Release and Consent Agreement. *
- ✓ If attending a qualifying competition or traveling as a part of Team USA and/or International Selection Pool (ISP), must be a full member of the [Professional Skaters Association \(PSA\)](#).

Learn to Skate USA Coach:

- ✓ Must be a current full member of U.S. Figure Skating either through a member club or as an individual member OR Learn to Skate USA instructor membership
- ✓ If 18 years or older, must submit information for, proper payment of \$30 and successfully pass a background check. *
 - The background check will be valid for two seasons, the one in which it was completed plus one additional.
- ✓ If 18 years or older, must complete annual SafeSport Training. *
 - The training will be valid for 365 days from date of completion and there is no cost for the training/certification.
- ✓ Learn to Skate USA Instructor Certification completed OR U.S. Figure Skating compliance coach (details above)

Foreign Coach/Choreographer:

- ✓ Required to present the LOC with a letter from their federation verifying they are a member in good standing.

Coaches must check in at the event registration desk and show government issued photo I.D. to receive a credential. If a coach cannot provide such identification and can not produce the necessary documents, they will not be allowed a credential. Non-credentialed coaches are not allowed to participate the event. There will be no exceptions to this policy.
