SkateSafe Volunteer Requirements

The SkateSafe program training and education is provided through an online platform that educates our members and assists in the prevention of harassment and abuse within our sport. Volunteers with close contact to skaters (e.g., locker room monitors) are required to complete this training and consent to a background check.

Accessing the Training

The training consists of three courses which take 30-45 minutes each to complete. You can start and stop the training at any time. If you stop prior to completion, you will return to the same place where you left off. Each course consists of a pre-test, videos, learning scenarios, and a final test that you must pass.

To access the program through the Members Only site of U.S. Figure Skating:

- login to your account,
- click on the SkateSafe icon
- follow the instructions to create an account and access the training.

Once you have completed the training and the background check, please forward your email certifications to the Ice Show Chair at atlantafsciceshow2020@gmail.com.

Program Costs

The program is free, and the background check will be reimbursed by the club. You should pay for the background check through the USFS website when you do your training, and submit an [Expense Reimbursement Form](#) along with your email certification and payment receipt.
