Solo & Feature Qualifications

All participants must be current Atlanta FSC members.

Eligibility will be based on tests passed as of December 20 (the Early Bird registration deadline) and will be verified by the ASFC Test Chair.

Group Numbers, Theatrical Interludes, and Closing Ensemble

All skaters will perform in one full-length Group Number, one Theatrical Interlude, and the Closing Ensemble.

- Skaters will be divided into groups according to age, skill level, and group size.
- Initial group assignments will be made once as Early Bird registration closes on December 20 and confirmed at the first rehearsal during the first week of January.
- Group Number and Theatrical interlude costumes will be covered by the entry fee, *although additional pieces may need to be provided by the skater.*

Guaranteed Solos

These skaters will automatically be awarded a Solo due to their high level of achievement:

- International competitor
- U.S. Championships competitor
- Qualifying Championship Series medalist (1st-4th)
- U.S. Adult Championships free skate or dance medalist (1st-4th), Silver and above
- National Showcase final round medalist (1st-4th)
- National Solo Dance Series Final medalist (1st-4th)
- U.S. Collegiate Championships free skate medalist (1st-4th)
- USFS S.T.A.R.S. national or regional winner
- Passed one of the following tests (must be currently actively competing)
 - Senior free skate test
 - Gold dance test
 - Senior pairs test
 - Senior/Gold (couples) dance test

- Adult gold free skate test

Soloist costumes will be provided by the skater.

- If a Soloist elects to also participate in a Group Number and/or Theatrical Interlude, that costume will be covered by the entry fee.

All Solos will be limited in time based on free skate level in order to control the length of the show while rewarding as many skaters as possible.

Potential Solos

Guaranteed Features: Duos, Trios and Step-outs

Depending on the number of skaters in the Guaranteed Solos category, the following skaters may be added for a Solo with a specific time length.

If we are unable to accommodate additional Solos, these skaters will be guaranteed a Feature. A Feature is defined as a Duo, Trio, or a 'Step-out' within a Group Number.

- Qualifying Championship Series competitor
- National Showcase final round competitor (must be more than 1 flight)
- U.S. Adult Championships showcase medalist (1st-4th), Silver and above
- U.S. Collegiate Championships free skate final round competitor (must be more than 1 flight)
- Passed one of the following tests (must be currently actively competing):
 - Senior free skate test
 - Gold dance test
 - Senior pairs test
 - Senior/Gold (couples) dance test
 - Adult gold free skate test
 - Junior free skate test

Feature Skater costumes will be provided by the skater.

- If a Featured Skater elects to also participate in a Group Number and/or Theatrical Interlude, that costume will be covered by the entry fee.

All features will be limited in time based on free skate level in order to control the length of the show while rewarding as many skaters as possible.

Potential Features: Duos, Trios and Step-outs

Depending on the number of skaters participating in the Guaranteed Features category, the following skaters may be added for a Feature with a specific time length.

- Passed Novice free skate test
- Graduating high school senior
- Non-qualifying Championship Series competitor
- National Showcase competitor
- National Solo Dance Series final competitor
- Adult Eastern Championships free skate medalist (1st-4th), Silver and above
