

Welcome to the ASFC 2024 Ice Show!

Get Up on the Dance Floor!

The Atlanta FSC is excited to announce our annual Spring Ice Show!

<u>Get Up on the Dance Floor!</u> celebrates the diverse world of dance and imagines how it influences the sport of figure skating. From ballroom to disco, jazz and voguing, and even dance fads like flossing and the Macarena, this year's spring show integrates one of the most ubiquitous forms of human expression with another year of amazing skating for the Atlanta Figure Skating Club.

Performances

We will have two performances this year: Saturday April 27th at 2 p.m. and 7p.m.

- Skaters will arrive and check-in at 1 p.m. for the afternoon show, which will not last longer than two hours (including intermission).
- Between 4-6 p.m., skaters will have a break for dinner.
- Skaters will check-in again at 6 p.m. for the evening performance.
- The second performance will start at 7 p.m.
- The show will wrap up around 9 p.m. on Saturday evening.

Registration Policies & Entry Fees

All full, adult, and bridge skating members of the Atlanta FSC are eligible to register.

- We also welcome participation from those currently enrolled in Learn to Skate at The Cooler!
- The Learn to Skate sign-up will be separate from the initial registration period, as those skaters will need to be in our Learn to Skate classes during the time of the show.

All participating coaches must be registered and compliant with U.S. Figure Skating, which includes background screening and proof of liability insurance.

Early Bird Discount: Entry Fee = \$119

So that we can best prepare for the first rehearsals in January 2023, we are offering a discount for Early Bird Registration.

- You will receive the Early Bird Discount if you register online by 11:59 p.m. on Friday, December 22.
- At this time, we want to know who our skaters will be so we can put together group numbers and rehearsal times, and therefore, notify everyone about their schedule as soon as possible.

Final Registration Deadline: Entry Fee = \$129

- Final Registration DUE 11:59 p.m. on Sunday, December 31.
- The entry fee includes a costume for one group number, one Theatrical Interlude, professional videography of the show, all Club Ice practice sessions, all coaching, ice rental during the shows, and an on-ice dress rehearsal.
- Exceptions to the final deadline will be permitted pending approval from the Ice Show Director and Producer!

Volunteer Requirements

The success of the show will depend on the support of our volunteers, and opportunities will abound!

A minimum of two hours of Spring Ice Show volunteer time is required of each participant. These hours will NOT count toward your Atlanta FSC service hours.

Each performance group will require at least one parent Group Coordinator and one Costume parent.

We will also need assistance with prop construction, set-up and breakdown, lighting, ticket and program sales, ushers, backstage chaperones, costume construction, make-up, etc.

The more helping hands we have, the better the show we can produce!

You may indicate volunteer preferences during registration; however, we cannot guarantee first preferences as we also need to cover all positions.

All volunteers must be age 18+.

SafeSport Volunteer Requirements

The SafeSport program training and education is provided through an online platform that educates our members and assists in the prevention of harassment and abuse within our sport.

Volunteers with close contact with skaters (e.g., locker room monitors) are required to complete this training and consent to a background check.

Group Numbers, Theatrical Interludes, Solos, and Features

All skaters will perform in one full-length Group Number, one Theatrical Interlude, and the Closing Ensemble.

- Skaters will be divided into groups according to age, skill level, and group size.
- Initial group assignments will be made once registration closes on December 31 and confirmed at the first rehearsal during the second week of January.
- Group Number and Theatrical interlude costumes will be covered by the entry fee.

Theatrical Interludes are an exciting addition to recent shows, as they will allow everyone to skate at least three times: Group Number, Theatrical Interlude, and Finale. As the name suggests, these numbers will be more 'theatrical' in nature and involve more storytelling and skater interaction than jumps, spins and other 'free skating' elements.

As always, Solos and Features will be limited in number and length to control the length of the show while celebrating as many skaters as possible.

Qualifications and policies are determined by guidelines.

We are currently in the process of revising and updating these guidelines to reflect the new USFS competition rules and testing guidelines, but as we always have, solos and features and group assignments will be based on test levels and competition results.

Rehearsal Schedule

The majority of the group numbers will be taught on Friday night during Club Ice.

Coaches may add their own additional sessions asnecessary.

Skaters will also be required to attend the Finale Rehearsal / Program Photos practice: date & time TBD. The past two years, we've held this session from 8 a.m. until noon on Sunday morning.

Photo & Videography

We are excited to announce that this year's fee also includes videography of the show, including a free download of both performances!

For the safety and welfare of the skaters, flash photography and videotaping will NOT be permitted.

Ticket Sales

Tickets will be available for advance online purchase as well as at the door.

Please check the Spring Show Bulletin Board for updates. Also, keep an eye on your email and the club website for more info.

Show Time

Only <u>credentialed</u> Local Organizing Committee members, the Atlanta FSC Board of Directors, participating coaches, and <u>assigned</u> volunteers will be permitted backstage during the dress rehearsal and performances!

Pre-show warmups will be available on the Blue Rink for solo, feature, and invited guest performers.
